Weekly Educational Plan 2023

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Overview and Objectives

MUNA Youth is an Islamic faith-based youth group with the aim of developing vibrant Muslim communities and preserving religious commitment within the youth in America. MUNA Youth attempts to establish a brotherhood of active young Muslims who - through their friendship and connection - tie each other to the remembrance of Allah and keep one another close to the Deen of Islam.

This brotherhood of commitment and service is perpetuated through regular weekly activities in the cause of Islam, such as Da'wah activities in the beginning of the month, biweekly study sessions for learning the Qur'an and Islam, monthly meetings for organization and planning, regional events and gatherings for strengthening Islamic brotherhood and connection, and more.

These activities occur every month during the weekends in the following order:

1st Week: Da'wah Activity

Every month, Muslim youth and adults of every locale mobilize and jointly engage with the wider community in activities of Da'wah and outreach. The general goals of the Da'wah activities are to:

1) Develop the skills to effectively engage in Da'wah, 2) develop the materials and resources to aid in the dissemination of Islam's message, 3) gather and mobilize the Muslim community to effectively partake in Islamic outreach, 4) engage with the wider community in disseminating the message of Islam, and 5) imbue the call to Islam with acts of service towards the needy, the community, and the society.

2nd Week: General Education Session 1

One of the most effective ways of preserving Islam and brotherhood within our communities is through the implementation of a biweekly study session, an educational gathering designed to review and study basic Islamic knowledge required to be effective workers for the deen of Islam. In order to effectively serve its purpose, the study sessions should be held regularly and consistently, should be structured around constructive discussion topics about Islam, and organized in a manner in which the responsibilities of disseminating knowledge are distributed and all participants are engaged.

3rd Week: General Education Session 2

Study sessions should take place at least twice a month for continued educational development. And the occasional fifth weekend should be taken as an opportunity to plan fun and entertaining community events to build engagement and brotherhood.

4th Week: Organizational Associate Member Meeting

Active associates and members of the youth group meet monthly to discuss personal development, membership development, organizational goals and strategies, the past month's progress, the upcoming month's planning, and more. A crucial component of this is the maintenance of a personal portfolio that tracks each members' personal and Islamic development as well as their engagement with Da'wah and organizational work.

Education Plan

This document proposes an educational plan for the development of basic Islamic literacy required for the average Muslim to be effective workers for the deen of Islam. It seeks to establish a baseline grounding in the fundamentals of Islam and present it in a comprehensible manner easily digestible to the average Muslim and applicable to daily Muslim life.

The plan is broken up into several subjects which are meant to be studied in order. Each subject is accompanied by recommended reading material and lecture material. To maximize effectiveness, each subject should be broken down further into lessons that follow the pacing of the lecture and reading materials suggested, and biweekly study sessions should cover one lesson at a time. A detailed suggestion for the specific structure of the lessons will be provided later in this document, inshaAllah.

Responsibilities

In order to arrange the study sessions in such a manner to maximize benefits for all participants, the most active participants of the study sessions need to organize themselves into leadership roles and take upon themselves specialized responsibilities in the conducting of the study session. Once the active membership has grown sufficiently in number and talent, the roles may be regularly switched to keep all participants actively involved. The length of the study session may vary based on the enthusiasm and commitment of its participants, but in the interest of preserving attention and engagement, it should not exceed 90 minutes at maximum.

The following roles and responsibilities are needed for effective study sessions:

Moderator - Organizes the lesson plan and homework, and moderates the structure of the study session.

Secretary - Corresponds with all the participants to ensure attendance and compliance with duties.

Reciter - Prepares a recitation of the Quran with translation and explanation to open up the study session.

Presenter(s) - Presents the assigned topic of the study session, using verses from the Quran, Hadith from the Sunnah, discussion points from the assigned readings and videos, and other presentation tools and technologies. This responsibility can be divided between multiple people.

Participants - Participates in the study session by studying the reading/lecture material beforehand and interacting with the presenters throughout the study session with relevant questions and reflections.

Study Session Procedure:

01. The moderator opens with the prayer of praise for Allah in Arabic then English:

إِنَّ الْحَمْدَ لِلَّهِ نَحْمَدُهُ وَنَسْتَعِينُهُ وَنَسْتَغْفِرُهُ وَنَعُوذُ بِاللَّهِ مِنْ شُرُورِ أَنْفُسِنَا وَمِنْ سَيِّئَاتِ أَعْمَالِنَا مَنْ يَهْدِهِ اللَّهُ فَلَا مُضِلَّ لَهُ وَمَنْ يَضِلَّهُ فَلَا هَادِيَ لَهُ وَأَشْهَدُ أَنْ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَحْدَهُ لَا شَرِيكَ لَهُ وَأَشْهَدُ أَنَّ مُحَمَّدًا عَبْدُهُ وَرَسُولُهُ

“Praise belongs to Allah. We praise him, We beseech him, and seek his forgiveness. We ask Allah’s protection from the evils within ourselves and the evils of our actions. Whom Allah guides, none can misguide. And whom He leads astray, no one can guide. 02. The reciter recites some prepared verses from the Quran with translation and explanation, preferably relevant to the main topic of the study session.
03. The presenters conduct the core lesson of the study session in accordance with the educational plan, which should include relevant Ayaat from the Qur'an, Hadith from the Sunnah, and interactive discussions based on the assigned readings and lecture videos for the week.
04. The presenters commence an open Q&A discussion on the lesson topic with all participants.
05. The presenters conduct a prepared interactive group activity that's designed to test everyone's comprehension of the lesson topic. This could be anything, from Jeopardy to Kahoot.
06. The moderator reviews weekly reports, announces the lesson plan and homework for the next study session, including the assigned readings and lecture videos for everyone on next week's topic.
07. The moderator or reciter concludes the study session with a Du'a and Surah al- 'Asr.

Educational Curriculum

The proposed educational curriculum is divided into subjects and lessons. Each subject will be listed with its learning objectives and lessons. Each lesson will be listed with a brief description, relevant Quranic verses and Ahadith, textbook readings, and lecture video material. No specific date ranges have been specified in this document, to allow subchapters of varying levels the flexibility to follow this plan at the pace appropriate to their level, but all lessons are intended to be covered in the order listed.

The basic subjects of Islam are as follows:

Beliefs (Aqidah)- Studying the beliefs and worldview of Islam, including belief in Allah, Angels, Scripture, Prophets, Afterlife, and Predestination.

History (Tarikh) - Studying the early history of Islam from the life of the Prophet to the history of the Caliphate and the expansion of Islam, including the eras of the Rashidun, the Umayyads, the Abbasids, and more.

Scripture (Qur'an/Sunnah) - Studying the scriptures of Islam and the methodology of their interpretation, including Qur'an and its Ulum, Hadith and its Ulum, the history and development of theology and jurisprudence, and basic Usul al Fiqh.

Worship (Ibadah) - Studying the basic rules of worship in the Sharia according to the Hanafi school, including purification (Taharah), ritual prayers (Salah), alms tax (Zakah), fasting (Sawm), and pilgrimage (Hajj).

Lawful and Prohibited (Halal and Haram) - Studying the basic rules of personal law in the Sharia pertaining to the concepts of Halal and Haram, including the topics of food and drink, clothing and adornment, household affairs, work and livelihood, gender relationships, parent-child relationships, cultural customs, business dealings, recreation and entertainment, socialization, and relationships with non-Muslims.

Social Organization - Studying the methodology and organization of Islamic society, contemporary movements in the call to the implementation of Islam (Da'wah), the importance of organized movement

(Jama'at) for the establishment of Islam in light of Qur'an and Sunnah, and the methodology of the formation, maintenance, and leadership of an Islamic Da'wah Organization, and an introduction to MUNA and its constitution and organizational literature.

Family and Society (Ijtima) - Studying Islamic society from its centermost component: the Islamic family, including the role of men and women in society, rules of marriage and divorce, rights and responsibilities of spouses, rights and responsibilities of parents and children, and inheritance.

Economics (Iqtisad) - Studying the commercial and economic system of Islamic society, from the rules of Islamic contracts, legitimate and prohibited types of transactions, riba and gharar, types of Islamic partnerships and companies, macroeconomics, and comparison between Islamic economic ideals and contemporary economic realities.

Civics (Hakimiyah) - Studying the civics and governing system of Islamic society, including the concepts of unified Islamic leadership (Khilafah), electorate body (Ahlul Halli wal Aqd), consultative congress (Shura), judiciary and its procedures (Qadaa), executive government (Diwan), federal governance (Wilayat), military and laws of warfare (Jihad).

Criminal Justice (Jinayat) - Studying the criminal justice system of Islamic society, including evidentiary law, principles of jurisprudence (Qawaid Fiqhiyyah), inviolable crimes (Hudud), legal crimes (Ta'zir), restitution (Qisas/Diyya), and more.
