Subject:

a. I'man / Surah Baqarah (2:285)

Meaning: The Messenger has believed in what was revealed to him from his Lord, and [so have] the believers. All of them have believed in Allah and His angels and His books and His messengers, [saying], "We make no distinction between any of His messengers." And they say, "We hear and we obey. [We seek] Your forgiveness, our Lord, and to You is the [final] destination." [2:285]

b. Islam / Ale-Imran 3:19

Meaning: Indeed, the religion in the sight of Allah is Islam. And those who were given the Scripture did not differ except after knowledge had come to them – out of jealous animosity between themselves. And whoever disbelieves in the verses of Allah, then indeed, Allah is swift in [taking] account. [3:19]

c. Akhirah / Al-Araf (7:187)

Meaning: They ask you, [O Muhammad], about the Hour: when is its arrival? Say, "Its knowledge is only with my Lord. None will reveal its time except Him. It lays heavily upon the heavens and the earth. It will not come upon you except unexpectedly." They ask you as if you are familiar with it. Say, "Its knowledge is only with Allah, but most of the people do not know." (7:187)

d. Islamic Movement/Sura Saff (61:09)

Meaning: It is He who sent His Messenger with guidance and the religion of truth to manifest it over all religion, although those who associate others with Allah dislike it. [61:9]

e. Dawah/Surah An-Nahl:125

بِمَن ضَلَّ عَن سَبِيلِهِ وَهُوَ أَعْلَمُ بِالْمُهُتَدِينَ

Meaning: Invite to the way of your Lord with wisdom and good instruction, and argue with them in a way that is best. Indeed, your Lord is most knowing of who has strayed from His way, and He is most knowing of who is [rightly] guided. [16:125]

As-Sajdah:33

Meaning: And who is better in speech than one who invites to Allah and does righteousness and says, "Indeed, I am of the Muslims." [41:33]

f. Islamic Organization/Sura Al-Imran:103

Meaning: And hold firmly to the rope of Allah all together and do not become divided. And remember the favor of Allah upon you – when you were enemies and He brought your hearts together and you became, by His favor, brothers. And you were on the edge of a pit of the Fire, and He saved you from it. Thus does Allah make clear to you His verses that you may be guided. [3:103]

g. **Education**/ Surah Jum'a :2

Meaning: It is He who has sent among the unlettered a Messenger from themselves reciting to them His verses and purifying them and teaching them the Book and wisdom – although they were before in clear error [62:2]

h. Social service/ Sura Al-Imran:110

Meaning: You are the best nation produced [as an example] for mankind. You enjoin what is right and forbid what is wrong and believe in Allah. If only the People of the Scripture had believed, it would have been better for them. Among them are believers, but most of them are defiantly disobedient. [3:110]

i. Relationship/Surah Hujurat:10

Meaning: The believers are but brothers, so make settlement between your brothers. And fear Allah that you may receive mercy. [49:10]

Sura Ale-Imran:103

j. Halal and Haram/ Surah Baqarah 172, 273

O you who have believed, eat from the good [i.e., lawful] things which We have provided for you and be grateful to Allāh if it is [indeed] Him that you worship. (2:172)

He has only forbidden to you dead animals, 1 blood, the flesh of swine, and that which has been dedicated to other than Allāh. But whoever is forced [by necessity], neither desiring [it] nor transgressing [its limit], there is no sin upon him. Indeed, Allāh is Forgiving and Merciful. (2:173

Sura Ale-Imran:130

Meaning: O you who have believed, do not consume usury, doubled and multiplied, but fear Allah that you may be successful. [3:130]

k. Tawbah/ Surah Tahrim 66:8

Their light will proceed before them and on their right; they will say, "Our Lord, perfect for us our light and forgive us. Indeed, You are over all things competent." [66:8]

1. **Death**/ Surah Ankabut 29:57

Meaning: Every soul will taste death. Then to Us will you be returned. [29:57]

m. Infaq fi'sabilillah/Surah Hadid 57: 10-11

Meaning: And why do you not spend in the cause of Allah while to Allah belongs the heritage of the heavens and the earth? Not equal among you are those who spent before the conquest [of Makkah] and fought [and those who did so after it]. Those are greater in degree than they who spent afterwards and fought. But to all Allah has promised the best [reward]. And Allah, with what you do, is Acquainted. [57:10]

Meaning: Who is it that would loan Allah a goodly loan so He will multiply it for him and he will have a noble reward? [57:11]

n. Witness the Truth (Surah Baqarah 2:143)

Meaning: And thus we have made you a just community that you will be witnesses over the people and the Messenger will be a witness over you. And We did not make the qiblah which you used to face except that We might make evident who would follow the Messenger from who would turn back on his heels. And indeed, it is difficult except for those whom Allah has guided. And never would Allah have caused you to lose your faith. Indeed Allah is, to the people, Kind and Merciful. [2:143]
